Purpose of Report

The Annual School Improvement Council Report to the Parents is issued by Broome High School in accordance with South Carolina law to share information on the school's





progress in meeting various goals and objectives, the work of the School Improvement Council, and other accomplishments during the school year.





Goals:

- School Climate increase the parent satisfaction with school safety from 91.4 % to 93.1% and increase student satisfaction with school safety from 93.1% to 94.5 %.
- Student Achievement increase the percentage of students scoring at the Silver level or better on WorkKeys to 67.5%, which was exceeded in 2015-2016 as our students scored 74.1%. Gradually increase to 77% by 2018-2019.
- Graduation rate increase the graduation rate to 84%.
- CATE Completers increase the number of CATE completers to 72.4%.
 - ACT increase the number of students that meet the college readiness benchmark on all four tests to 15%.
