Annual Goals/Needs

1. High quality instructional strategies will be provided in every classroom.

Actions:

- Continue Balanced Literacy lessons
- Use small guided reading and guided math groups
- Create common assessments
- Model and teach text dependent analysis
- Plan and teach engaging lessons

Outcomes/results:

- Improved differentiation of instruction
- Increased levels of student thinking

2. Provide Response to Intervention support for students performing below grade level.

Actions:

- Provide Leveled Literacy Intervention (LLI) reading small groups
- Provide Reading Recovery one-on-one instruction
- Implement strategies and collect and analyze assessment data

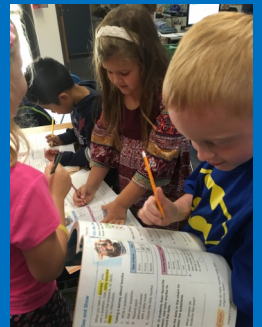
3. Provide a safe learning environment for students, teachers and support staff.

Actions:

- Continue positive rewards for student behavior.
- Implement Olweus bullying prevention class meetings.
- Prepare students for crisis situations.
- Increase the number of safety drills.
- Discuss and analyze a variety of safety scenarios.

Outcomes/Results:

- Quicker response to safety drills.
- Increase student awareness of safety.
- Decline in number of student discipline referrals.

- Provided Power Hour for academic support.
- Improved parent and community communication with digital sign.
- Received DonorsChoose grant to assist student needs.
- 82% of students reading at or above grade level.
