Schedule

Enclosed with this newsletter, is your schedule for the 2011-2012 school year. All questions regarding schedules should be directed to Mr. Fulmer <u>before</u> <u>July 20</u>. No changes to your schedule will be made at registration.

Fees

All fees will be paid at registration. Your class fees are listed on your schedule. Other possible fees include insurance, PE uniform, parking permit and lunch deposit.

Pictures

Physical Education Students

Students enrolled in PE will pay for their uniform at registration. Uniforms, however, are issued once school begins. PE students will also be issued locks for their PE lockers, once school begins.

Annual

Information regarding the purchase of annuals will be distributed during the first week of school.

Annuals, costing \$65, will be purchased directly from Jostens which will accept credit cards and extended payment plans.

Seniors may have their names engraved on the front cover for an additional \$3.00.

Dress Code

The dress code is outlined in your handbook. Follow the dress code at registration and on the first day of school. Be reminded of the following when you are shopping for school clothes:

- **No shorts-including athletic shorts of any type
- **Shorts must extend to the top of the kneecap
- **Capri pants (for both boys and girls) must extend *below* the knee, to the top of the calf
- **Skirts should extend to the top of the knee
- **Girls' tank-type tops should cover the width of the shoulder
- **No exposed midriffs
- ** Pants and shorts may not have holes, frays, or patches
- **Hair feathers are restricted to colors that exist naturally in human hair

Student Drivers

All students who plan to drive to school must purchase a Woodruff High School Parking Sticker for \$3.00.

No 9th graders will be allowed to drive to school.

Handbook

Students will be given a handbook at registration. All students should bring their handbook during the first week of school.
