School Improvement Council Report to Parents 2025-2026

Purpose The purpose of Woodruff Elementary School is to create a community of learners where each student is provided with a quality education in a safe, supportive environment that promotes self-discipline, motivation, and excellence in learning to manage life's challenges successfully.

Direction Our students will be engaged in meaningful experiences to fully develop social, emotional, physical, and intellectual talents and abilities during their educational journey and throughout their lives.

School Improvement Goals Student Achievement Goal-

A big goal for our school is improving how we reach economically disadvantaged students. We want to see third through fifth graders increase their performance on SC READY assessments. Our goal was for at least 55% of economically disadvantaged students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the ELA test by 2030. Currently we have 59.4% based on the 2025 SC Ready assessment so we want to maintain this number and keep it above the 55th percentile. In Math, our goal was for at least 55% of economically disadvantaged students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the SC Ready test. Currently we have 54.7% based on the 2025 SC Ready assessment. We want to continue to focus on this group with a goal of at least 55% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the ELA test and on the Math test by 2030.

Another focus is our gifted population. Our goal is for 75% of our gifted students to score "exceeds" on SC Ready by 2030.

Teacher/Administrator Quality Goal- Our teacher/administrator quality goal is to increase advanced teacher certifications and/or endorsements from 1% to 25% by 2030. The 1% is a baseline for the certifications and endorsements that are offered through our district.

School Climate Goal- Our school climate goal is by May of 2030, 70% of parents will agree on the WES survey that they have attended more than two events during the school year.

School Report Card rating- Woodruff Elementary School received a "Good" rating for the 2024-2025 school year. This was an increase from the previous year which was an "Average" rating.

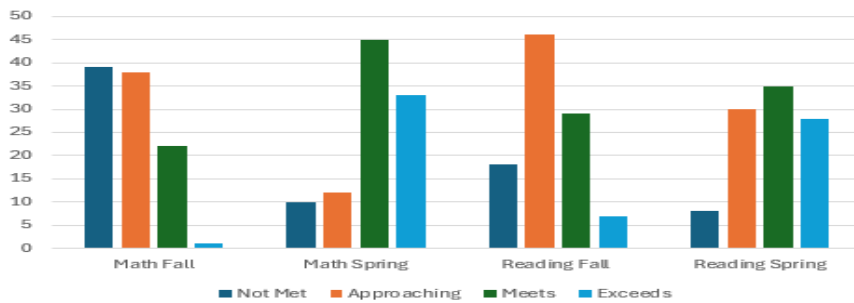

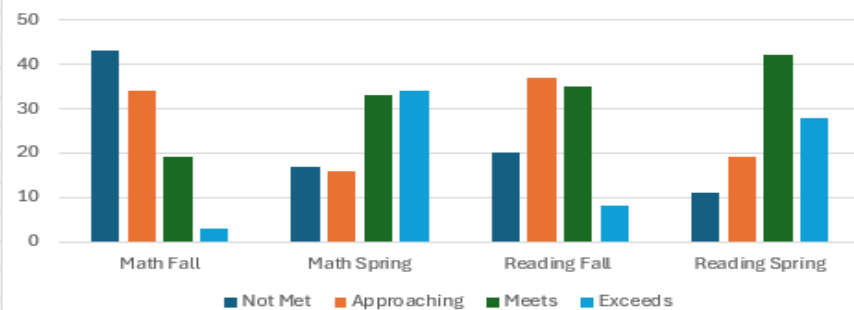

2025-2026



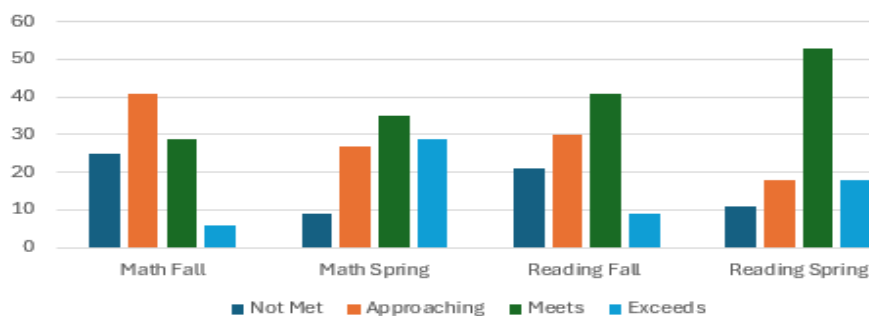
