School Improvement Goals 2023-2024

Student Achievement Goal-

A big goal for our school is improving how we reach economically disadvantaged students. We want to see third through fifth graders increase their performance on SCREADY tests. The goal is for at least 50% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the ELA test and for at least 55% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the Math test. We would like to meet this goal by 2025.

Teacher/Administrator Quality Goal-

We want to increase the number of teachers who hold advanced degrees, certifications, or endorsements. The goal is to increase this number from 54 to 69 by 2025.

School Climate Goal-

We are working to increase the quality and quantity (number of available opportunities) of relevant professional development. In order to measure this, our goal is that 65% of teachers would rate this as "agree" on the SC Teachers Survey- a part of the SC Report Card for Schools.






