Purpose The purpose of Woodruff Elementary School is to create a community of learners where each student is provided with a quality education in a safe, supportive environment that promotes self-discipline, motivation, and excellence in learning to manage life's challenges successfully.

Direction Our students will be engaged in meaningful experiences to fully develop social, emotional, physical, and intellectual talents and abilities during their educational journey and throughout their lives.

School Improvement Goals

Student Achievement Goal- A big goal for our school is improving how we reach economically disadvantaged students. We want to see third through fifth graders increase their performance on SC READY assessments. Our previous goal was for at least 50% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the ELA test by 2025. Currently we have 48.2% based on the 2024 SC Ready assessment. Our previous goal was for at least 55% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the Math test. Currently we have 51.3% based on the 2024 SC Ready assessment. We will continue prioritizing this group with a new goal of having at least 55% of these students achieve a "Meets" or "Exceeds" score on the ELA and Math assessment by 2030.

Another focus is our gifted population. Our goal is for 75% of our gifted students to score "exceeds" on SC Ready by 2030.

Teacher/Administrator Quality Goal- Our previous goal was to increase the number of teachers who hold advanced degrees, certifications, or endorsements from 54 to 69 by 2025. We met this goal with 93 advanced degrees, certification, or endorsements. Our new goal is <a href="https://documents.org/thososopy.center-unities.org/thososo

School Climate Goal- Our previous goal was to increase the quality and quantity of relevant professional development with 65% of teachers agreeing on the SC Teachers Survey- a part of the SC Report Card for Schools. We met this goal with over 77.8% of teachers agreeing on the survey. Our new goal is by May of 2030, 70% of parents will agree on the WES survey that they have attended more than two events during the school year.






