Our students will be engaged in meaningful experiences to fully develop social, emotional, physical and intellectual talents and abilities during their educational journey and throughout their lives.

## SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT GOALS 2020-2021

### **Student Achievement Goal-**

A big goal for our school is improving how we reach economically disadvantaged students. We want to see third through fifth graders increase their performance on SCREADY tests. The goal is for at least 38.5% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the ELA test and for at least 43% of these students to score "meets" or "exceeds" on the Math test. By the 2025 school year, our goal is for these percentages to increase to 50% and 55% respectively.

## **Teacher/Administrator Quailty Goal-**

We want to increase the number of teacher degrees, certifications, or endorsements. The goal is to increase this number from 54-57 by the end of the 2020-21 school year, and from 54-69 by 2025.

#### **School Climate Goal-**

We are working to increase the quality and quantity (number of available opportunities) of relevant professional development. In order to measure this, our goal is that 65% of teachers would rate this as "agree" on the SC Teachers Survey by 2025- a part of the SC Report Card for Schools.






