We are proud of what we have accomplished, but we have more goals to pursue and more achievements to earn.

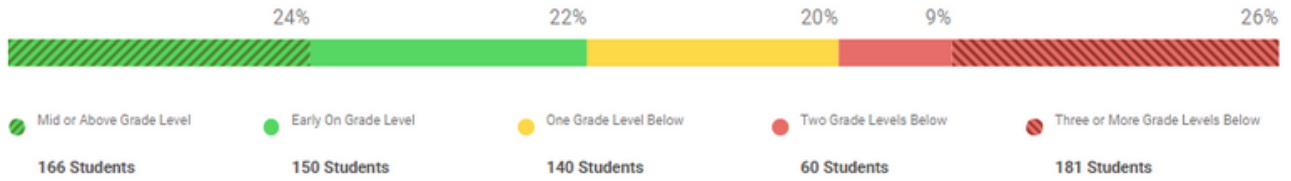

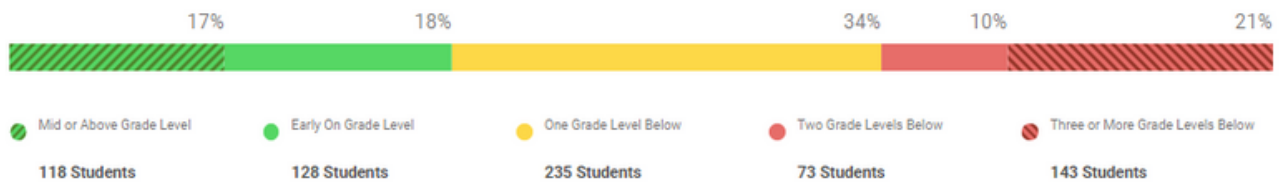
