School Progress and Highlights

Reidville Elementary continues to be a special school where students have many opportunities to participate in extracurricular events and grow their unique talents.

All students have chromebooks for daily use. These were especially helpful during virtual and e-learning days.

Students and their families participated in several service learning projects: Relay for Life, American Heart Association, Valentine's for Seniors, American Red Cross, Middle Tyger Community Center, and lastly, P.S. I Love You Ministries.

School-wide learning opportunities included a Vocabulary Parade, Macy's Parade, Careers on Wheels, Red Ribbon Week, and Book Character Day.
