School Progress and Highlights

Reidville Elementary continues to be a special school where students have many opportunities to participate in extra-curricular events and grow their unique talents. Families are often invited into the school to celebrate this learning.

All 3rd and 4th grade students are equipped with laptops to encourage blended learning through technology.

Students participated in numerous service learning projects: Spartanburg Humane Society, The Children's Hospital, and Middle Tyger Community Center.

School-wide learning opportunities included a Veteran's Day Celebration, Vocabulary Parade, Macy's Parade, and book buddies.

All students participated in Jump Rope for Heart a physical fitness initiative to promote a healthy heart.

Due to COVID-19 our school year was interrupted forcing our building to close for the last nine weeks of school. During this closure teachers relied heavily on SeeSaw to provide distance learning for students and communicate with parents. SeeSaw usage increased dramatically. Prior to the closure we averaged 800 new posts per week by students. During the week of April 19, students created 8,725 SeeSaw posts.
