Goals for classrooms for the 2017/2018 School Year:

 - * Students in third and fourth grade will score on grade level on the S.C. Ready test

- * Special Needs students will be served in the general education classroom
 - * Students will have weekly Olweus (bullying prevention) meetings in the classroom
 - * Teacher will attend Compassionate Schools Training
