




#### PASS 2013 Summary:



# MAP Assessment (Fall, 2012-Spring, 2013)









Students in Kindergarten through grade 4 are given the MAP assessment in reading and in math in the Fall and in the Spring. Their achievement gains are measured as a RIT score. The graphs on the left display the achievement gains of this year's students. These Fall RIT scores compare the grade level class in 2012 to the same grade level class in the Spring RIT scores in 2013. MAP assessment data helps teachers plan more individualized instruction.
