At a glance (2021-2022)

- 981 students
- 76% of students earned needed credits for promotion during the first semester (earned 4+ credits)
- 402 students on A/B Honor Roll (Q3)

- 376 students will be invited to the Beta Club with a 3.75 GPA (through Q3)
