Data at a Glance

- 1037 students
- Over 650 students earned A/B Honor Roll for at least one quarter during the year (Q1-Q3)
- 398 students invited to join the Beta Club with a 4.0 GPA (weighted)

- 97.3% of students were on-time sophomores (22-23)
