Bamberg-Ehrhardt's students and staff had another successful year!

Bamberg-Ehrhardt High School has continued to expand our course offerings in our Career and Technical Education Department (CATE). BEHS' students had opportunities to complete programs in Business Information Management, Culinary Arts, Agricultural Science, Health Science, Law Enforcement and Family and Consumer Science. Students had the opportunity to attend Cope Area Career Center and complete programs such as Automotive Technology, Cosmetology, Early Childhood Education, Project Lead the Way, and Welding Technology.

Bamberg-Ehrhardt High School offered dual enrollment courses in conjunction with Orangeburg-Calhoun Technical College, Denmark Technical College and USC Salkehatchie. The Dual Enrollment program allowed eligible high school students the opportunity to earn both high school and college credits by successfully completing college courses. Courses such as English 101/102, Math 120/130, Biology 101/102 and Project Lead the Way were offered on our campus.

Extra-curricula activities have also been successful. The softball team won it's first ever State Championship. Volleyball and football both won Lower-State Championships. BEHS' track team won region and several track members won individual State Championships. Both varsity basketball teams, soccer, wrestling and baseball made the play-offs.
