EP Todd continued to make great strides in the 2022 – 2023 school year. This year the school earned its highest rating of “GOOD” on the annual report card. We climbed three categories and had the greatest growth of any Spartanburg School District 7 school! It was a wonderful way to begin our year.

We set rigorous academic goals that we tracked through the iReady Diagnostic Assessments. We continue to analyze our data and focus on our areas of need. This year, we had a strong focus on reading intervention and supports for students. We also recognize that our math growth is not as strong as our reading growth.

Through a focus on Continuous Improvement, we will redesign our intervention plan to include mathematics support as well as reading. Our faculty and leadership team are also work diligently to ensure the best possible instruction for our students. We have three instructional coaches that meet regularly with our teachers to support planning and implementing instruction. All of our returning teachers have been training in Continuous Improvement practices and began implementing PDSA cycles (plan-do-study-act) to better engage our students in the learning process.

We will always maintain a strong academic focus, but were so very excited to be able to infuse engaging family nights and performance opportunities for students in this school year. These are the memories that will carry on in their future!

## Five-Year School Improvement Plan Goals

### Performance Goal 1

The percentage of students scoring Meets Expectations and Exceeds Expectations on SC READY ELA will increase from 32% in 2020-21 to 46.2% in 2025-26.

### Performance Goal 2

The percentage of students scoring Meets Expectations and Exceeds Expectations on SC READY Math will increase from 25.7% in 2020-21 to 37.3% in 2025-26.

### Performance Goal 3

100% of E. P. Todd's teachers will implement instructional framework practices in ELA and mathematics lessons by 2025-2026.

### Performance Goal 4

E. P. Todd School will improve the percent of students, teachers, and parents' satisfaction level with school-home relations from 82%, 61% & 63%, respectively to 85% by 2025-2026 by creating more involvement opportunities.



## Academic Progress

### READING GOALS – 2023

- INCREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS SCORING IN TIER I IREADY FROM 20% TO 55%
  - *SPRING INCREASED TO 60%!*
- DECREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS SCORING IN TIER 3 IREADY FROM 30% TO 15%
  - *SPRING DECREASED TO 14%!*

### MATH GOALS – 2022

- INCREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS SCORING IN TIER I IREADY FROM 10% TO 45%
  - *SPRING INCREASED TO 60%!*
- DECREASE THE PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS SCORING IN TIER 3 IREADY FROM 35% TO 14%
  - *SPRING DECREASED TO 11%!*
