

School Renewal Plan Goals

Ebenezer Middle School will:

1. Increase the percentage of students scoring "Met" or "Above" on the SC Ready ELA assessment from 34.9% to 37.1%, SC Ready math assessment from 13.9% to 19.1%, and the SC Ready Science assessment from 31.5% to 46.5%.
2. Decrease the number of discipline referrals by 10%.
3. Increase parents/stakeholders satisfaction from 77.8% to 87.8%.
4. Continue to utilize the procedures in various areas (hallway, cafeteria, etc.) to maintain effective and smooth operation during the school day.

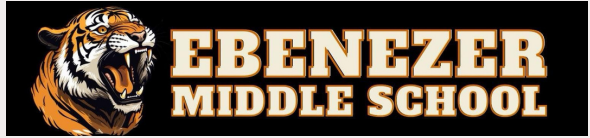
