SIC Annual Goals

Student Achievement

In spring of 2015, students completed ACT Aspire assessments—in the areas of reading, English, mathematics and writing. Overall. students scored Above National Level for fourth grade **Writing**. In addition, students in grades four and five completed SC Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (SCPASS) in social studies and science. Fifth grade students scored Above State **Level** in science. To improve student achievement, staff and administrators continue to focus on core instructional activities that strengthen academic achievement and increase student performance.

Teacher Quality

To ensure the employment of highly qualified teachers and paraprofessionals, administrators emphasize retention and recruitment, specialized training opportunities, and personal growth. In addition, new teachers also receive mentors, who offer assistance, as needed.

School Quality

Collected data from surveys, discipline reports, and attendance records indicate improving home and school relations. Students have a sense of order, safety, and self-worth. Parental results indicate the need for more assistance in becoming effective partners in the education of their children and in obtaining services from outside sources. The staff implemented strategies that will allow both groups to have their needs met.

Read to Succeed

On June 5, 2014, the South Carolina General Assembly passed the Read to Succeed Act. This act mandated -offering professional development sessions or course work in literacy for teachers and staff, employing a reading coach, creating a School Reading Plan, offering a Summer Reading Camp for students who are at least one grade level behind in reading, and retaining third grade students who are not reading on grade level by 2017-2018.

Students participate in formative and summative assessments—GOLD, state mandated, measures pre-kindergarten literacy skills, twice yearly; DRA2-state mandated, measures kindergarten reading skills, three times yearly; Next Steps In Guided Reading Assessment (NSGR)-district assessment, measures grades one through five reading skills, three times yearly; Measures of Academic Progress (MAP)-district assessment, compares students locally and nationally in reading, math and language and measures achievement for placement in the gifted and talented program, three times vearly; **Benchmarks-**district quarterly assessments. measure progress toward meeting state standards; and Pre-Post Tests-district assessments, in science and social studies, provide baselines academic growth.
