NEEDS ASSESSMENT

The school's renewal plan was developed through planning with a committee that consisted of community members, school level administrators, teachers and parents. Goals were developed based upon data from students' performance on the Palmetto Assessment of State Standards (PASS), Measure of Academic Performance (MAP), and Benchmark Tests. Other information was obtained from our Teacher-Parent-Student Perception Surveys, and other forms of formative and summative assessment. The school renewal plan has been reviewed by the superintendent and was submitted to the school board of trustees for approval.

Student Achievement

The school's leadership team presented data from the calculation of absolute value needed to meet expected progress. After analyzing the data, the root causes of students' underachievement were identified. Research-based, best-practice procedures were utilized to address weaknesses for all students. Data walls displaying students' test performance indicate overall growth in student achievement in all grade levels. Continual data analysis, effective instruction, professional development, and instructional conferences coupled with support and monitoring by the leadership team will continue to be emphasized to ensure continued growth in student achievement.

School Climate

We continue to foster efforts that strengthen home-school communication, and promote parental and community involvement. Renovations to the building and grounds have been completed, which adds to a climate that is beautiful and nurturing—assuring academic excellence for all students.

Teacher Quality

Teachers continue to gain from professional development by participating in professional learning communities, graduate courses, School Improvement Workshops, etc. Through collaboration, a culture for retention of highly qualified teachers has been developed. R.E. Davis has 100% highly qualified teachers.

Accomplishments, Programs, Awards and Honors

R.E. Davis maintains accreditation by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. We continue to utilize advanced technology, as all classrooms have Promethean Boards for interactive learning, laptop computers and LCD projectors are available for check-out from our media center, and students and teachers benefit from researched-based and web-based interactive programs and software (Achieve3000 and Study Island, etc.) Additionally, we have an active media literacy team of students that produces our morning show through Web 2.0 Movie Maker. R.E. Davis continues to promote literacy through the Accelerated Reader program. Other activities include Read Across America Day; Heart Association Fundraiser, Red Ribbon and Drug Awareness Week, Relay for Life, Star Student Program, etc. R.E. Davis has been presented the travel plaque for having this year's State Superintendent's Writing Award winner, Tyrell Commander, a fifth grader. We were also awarded the Palmetto Silver Award for academic performance, and for closing the achievement gap.
