Goals

Goal #1

By May 2022, 85% of kindergarten students will achieve "Meets" or "Exceeds" on the listening comprehension portion of the MAP Reading Fluency Assessment as compared to the Spring 2021 percentage of achieving "Meets" or "Exceeds."

Goal #2

By May 2022, 70% of first grade students will achieve "Meets" or "Exceeds" on the listening comprehension portion of the MAP Reading Fluency Assessment as compared to the Spring 2021 percentage of achieving "Meets" or "Exceeds."

Goal #3

By May 2022, 85% of students will be able to identify and produce grade level appropriate letters/sounds as indicated by a letter/sound checklist.

Goal #4

By May 2022, 85% of our first grade students will score at or above grade level in Math as measured by the Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessment.



Literacy, S.T.E.M. and the Arts

Literacy, S.T.E.M. (science, technology, engineering, and math) and the fine arts are at the core of nearly all that we do here at Oakland Primary School. We maintain an online library of more than 1900 books available to our students 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. We recently received a grant to open a Ben Carson Reading Room here at Oakland Primary, one of only 200 across the nation. It will be the center piece of our literacy program once opened and functioning. This year we opened and staffed a full time S.T.E.M. lab that every child gets an opportunity visit once a week to explore through hands-on science activities. Our fine arts program is second none and the works of art produced by our students are incredibly complex, detailed, and beautiful. We make music a part of everyday life here at Oakland with a choral program and weekly music instruction. Everything we do hinges on healthy students and our physical education program provides movement and conditioning practice which will last a lifetime. Our Afterschool programs provides tutoring where necessary but also provides enrichment for advanced students including, robotics, journalism, photography, engineering and general science. We have teamed-up with our local faith community to provide the Character Under Construction program which teaches basic character skills to our students. We also provide specialized support to our large military community including a Deployment Group for our students who have parents that are deployed. Here at Oakland we really "Educate the Whole Child!"
