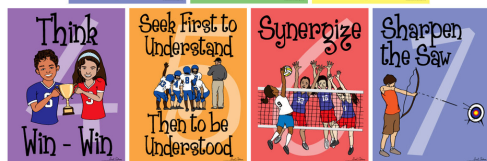

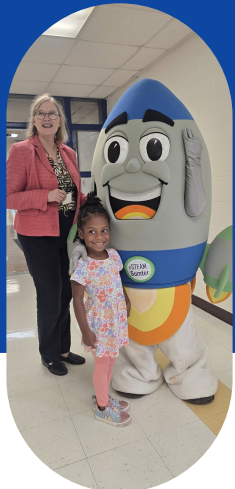


School Vision & Mission
