Improvement Priority 1:

Engage all Pocalla Springs Elementary School stakeholder groups in a systemic process to develop, monitor and build a commitment to a mission, vision and set of belief statements about teaching and learning that are anchored in high expectations for student learning and success.

Improvement Priority 2:

Establish, implement, monitor and communicate a systematic continuous improvement process that provides clear direction for improving conditions that support and impact instruction and student learning. Ensure the process includes the following: (1) a communication plan to inform all stakeholders, (2) procedures for analyzing and disaggregating data to identify academic and non-academic needs (3) assessment of high-yield instructional strategies that are evidence-based and lead to best practice instruction, and (4) systematic use of formal standard operating procedures based on research and best practices.

Improvement Priority 3:

Develop, implement and monitor a process to gather, analyze and use formative and summative data to improve learning for individual and collective groups of students. Provide professional development opportunities for teachers on data analysis. Provide teachers with time to reflect analyze and monitor student performance data and ensure that teachers are modifying instruction to address data results.
