

Performance Goals

Goal One: Our goal is to increase student attendance by 5% by May 2026 because consistent attendance is directly linked to stronger academic performance and long-term success. By improving daily attendance, we ensure students have more access to instruction, support, and learning opportunities that contribute to better outcomes.

Goal Two: Our goal is to increase the English 2 EOC scores by 10% by May 2026 because stronger literacy skills are essential for students success across all content areas and future opportunities. By improving performance from 43% to 53%, we ensure more students are meeting grade-level expectations and are better prepared for graduation and post-secondary pathways.

Goal Three: Our goal is to increase Algebra 1 scores by 10% by May 2026 because success in Algebra is a key predictor of high school graduation and readiness for advanced math courses. Raising proficiency from 10% to 20% ensures more students build strong foundational skills that support future academic and career opportunities.
