Performance Goals

Goal One: The percentage of tenth grade students who pass both parts of the HSAP by the spring and graduate two years later will increase by 5%.

Goal Two: The percentage of tenth grade students in the current school year who meet the standards on both HSAP subtests on the first attempt will increase by 5%.

Goal Three: The percentage of the SAT/ACT scores for the students in the spring graduating class who take the test and qualify for a state scholarship will increase by 5%.

Goal Four: The percentage of original ninth grade students who earn a standard high school diploma and graduate in four years will increase 3%.

Goal Five: The percentage of students who pass the State End-of-Course exam will increase by 5%.

Goal Six: Improve the atmosphere for learning and working by 2%.


