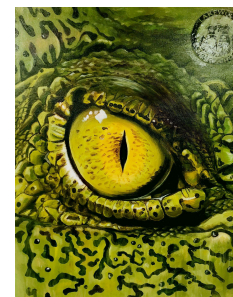
### Core Values and Beliefs
