## Achievements and Special Awards

ADMS 2012-2013 Campus Teacher of the Year, Mr. Trevor Ivey, was named District Teacher of the Year and is currently one of five finalists for South Carolina State Teacher of the Year.

Fifty-five students qualified to take the PSAT and thirteen were named Junior Scholars. Five students qualified for state recognition for Duke TIP. Six students made a perfect score on their 2012 PASS test.

ADMS students participated in raising over \$2000.00 for The Leukemia Society this year and over \$600.00 for the American Heart Association.

ADMS teachers held their first ever Community Extravaganza and raised over \$3000.00 for computer programs for their students with the support of sixty local businesses.

ADMS received funds through the Patriot Project Grant to purchase a class set of iPads and iPods that will facilitate STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) activities for not only our military students but all students at ADMS. We partnered with the Clemson Extension/4H program and successfully integrated STEM activities through our Tech Wizard and Robotics. ADMS was selected by S<sup>2</sup>TEM Centers SC and South Carolina's Coalition for Mathematics and Science for participation in the STEM School Support PILOT program which allowed us to develop strategies for implementing STEM. We started a partnership with USC-Sumter to help teachers in implementing STEM activities.

ADMS added ProTeam to its curriculum this year, making it one of sixteen schools in South Carolina to offer this award winning, early teacher recruitment course.

The ADMS football team won the Conference Championship, and ADMS girls' track team also won the Conference Championship.

Our Advanced Band had eight students make the South Carolina Region 5 Honor Band. They also made straight superior ratings at the 2013 SCBDA Concert Festival and received the SCBDA Outstanding Performance Award for 2013.

## Performance Goals 2012-2013

Provide a challenging curricula with high expectations for all students as measured by the growth in the percentage of students in grades 6-8 who score Met or above in ELA, math, science, and social studies as measured by PASS assessment, and increase in the performance on End-of-Course tests for those 8th graders taking English I and Algebra I.
