## **STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT**

In the spring of 2016, Alice Drive Elementary Third through Fifth grade students took the SC READY state assessment tests in English Language Arts and Mathematics. In this first year of the SC READY assessment, students scored above the district's average in English, Reading, Writing, and Mathematics. The SC PASS was given to students in grades four and five in the spring of 2016. Alice Drive Elementary scored above the district and state averages of students scoring at grade level or above in both science and social studies.
