MILLWOOD ELEMENTARY'S MISSION & VISION

The mission of Millwood Elementary School is to always put students first. The vision of Millwood Elementary School is to establish a safe environment focusing on attendance, academics, and behavior.

SIC Annual Goal #1 Increase Student Achievement

ELA Achievement – Subgroups 1–3
By June 2026, Subgroups 1–3 will increase the percentage of students scoring Meets or Exceeds on SC READY in English Language Arts as follows: Subgroup 1 from 47.3% to 50.3%, Subgroup 2 from 47.2% to 50.2%, and Subgroup 3 from 17.8% to 20.8%. This goal will be supported through differentiated instruction, targeted small-group interventions, and ongoing progress monitoring.

Math Achievement – Subgroups 1–3
By June 2026, Subgroups 1–3 will increase the percentage of students scoring Meets or Exceeds on SC READY in Math as follows: Subgroup 1 from 36.4% to 39.4%, Subgroup 2 from 36.5% to 39.5%, and Subgroup 3 from 15.6% to 18.6%. This goal will be supported through differentiated instruction, targeted small-group interventions, and ongoing progress monitoring.

SIC Annual Goal #2 Strengthen School Climate and Leadership

Millwood Elementary fosters a positive and supportive school culture by promoting student leadership and recognizing staff and student achievements. Programs such as the Morning Show, Student Council, Safety Patrol, Choir, and service projects allow students to practice the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People while building confidence, responsibility, and teamwork.

SIC Annual Goal #3 Increase Parent Involvement and Community Partnerships

Millwood Elementary values strong partnerships with families and the community. Parents are encouraged to participate in events such as Literacy and Math Nights, Title I workshops, Leader in Me family events, the Community Partner Breakfast, and volunteer opportunities that support student learning and leadership development.

By June 2026, the percentage of students in grades 3–5 identified as truant will decrease from 26% to 23%, representing a 3-percentage-point reduction, as measured by monthly attendance reports. This goal will be achieved through targeted supports, family engagement, and student recognition systems to promote consistent attendance.
