Student Achievement

In the spring of 2023, Willow Drive Elementary 3rd -5th grade students participated in SC Ready State assessments in ELA and Math. 4th-grade students also participated in the SC Ready Science assessment. A comparison for growth from the previous year along with an absolute overall rating was sent in the Fall of 2023. Another assessment utilized is the MAP test, which is administered three times a year (fall, winter, and spring). In comparing fall to spring growth, Willow Drive students can see where they will score on state testing.
