One of our continuous goals is to keep our parents and community informed. The purpose of this report is to share with parents and community members the school's achievements and student academic progress.

Chestnut Oaks Middle School SIC annual goals focus on three areas: student achievement, teacher/administrator quality, and school climate. The three goals are addressed below.

Goal 1: Fifteen percent (15%) of all students will demonstrate proficiency in ELA and math by June 2019 as evidence by SC Ready.

Goal 2: The rate of teacher retention will increase by twenty percent (20%). Teachers and staff will participate in professional learning opportunities that improve teacher effectiveness. We will continue to create a positive, professional environment for all teachers, staff, and administrators.

Goal 3: Decrease referrals by twenty percent (20%) by implementing a consistent, school-wide discipline model that follows best practices, PBIS, and Time to Teach strategies. Students take part in a SOAR walk to learn how to behave in a positive manner around the school. Teach To's will be implemented in each classroom by teachers to increase positive classroom behavior.
