

Sims Middle School 2024 Report Card Summary

Overall Rating:

Sims Middle School received an overall School Report Card rating of 43, which is classified as Average. The rating scale for middle schools is as follows: Excellent 56 to 100, Good: 48 to 55, Average: 36 to 47, Below Average: 29 to 35, Unsatisfactory: 28 and below.

Academic Achievement:

Sims Middle School's Academic Achievement rating is Below Average, scoring 11.90 out of 35 points. The rating scale is as follows: Excellent 20.1 to 35, Good: 16.72 to 20.09, Average: 12 to 16.71, Below Average: 8.37 to 11.99, Unsatisfactory: 8.36 and below.

SCREADY Assessment results:

English Language Arts (Reading and Writing): 34% of students met or exceeded expectations, compared to the UCSD middle average of 36.85% and the state average of 54.10%.

Mathematics: 24% of students met or exceeded expectations, while the UCSD middle average was 20.65% and the state average was 42.80%.

Student Progress: The Student Progress rating for Sims Middle School is Average, achieving 16.54 out of 35 points. The rating scale is as follows: Excellent 20.14 to 35, Good 17.18 to 20.13, Average 13.31 to 17.17, Below Average 10.15 to 13.37, Unsatisfactory 10.14 and below. Sims Middle School outperformed the district in all areas except for Students Meeting Median Annual Targets and Students Meeting Added-Value Targets.

Overall Percentage of Progress Points Earned: 47.3% (UCSD middle average: 39.65%, state average: 45%)

Lowest 20% of Student Population: 55.7% of progress points (UCSD middle average: 41.2%, state average: 45.0%).

Meeting Median Annual Targets: 46.5% (UCSD middle average: 42.0%, state average: 47.7%).

Students Meeting Added-Value Targets: 29.6% (UCSD middle average: 24.95%, state average: 33.0%).

In terms of overall progress, Sims Middle School earned 47.3% of available points, surpassing the district average of 39.65% and closely aligning with the state average of 45%. The school also achieved 48.1% of progress points across all student progress components, compared to the district average of 39.2% and the state average of 45%. The lowest 20% of students at Sims Middle School scored 55.7% of available progress points, while the district average was 41.2% and the state average was 45.0%. Furthermore, the school met its Median Annual Targets at a rate of 46.5%, above the district average of 42.0% but slightly below the state average of 47.7%. Lastly, 29.6% of students met Added-Value Targets, indicating they achieved more than a year's worth of academic growth, which is better than the district average of 24.95% but still under the state average of 33.0%.

Overall, while Sims Middle School has demonstrated strengths in various areas, there are opportunities for improvement, particularly in academic achievement metrics. The data reflects a commitment to progress and highlights the school's potential for further development.








Student Progress: Average
