D.O.E.S continues to aim for student achievement in the content areas are as follows:

- Student performance as indicated on MAP in ELA will improve by reducing the percent of students scoring at the low average achievement quartile from 29% to 19 % in the first through fifth grade.
- Student performance as indicated on MAP will improve by reducing the percent of students scoring at the low average achievement quartile from 33% to 20% in first through fifth grade.

Teachers continue to share data information from the TE21 and MAP assessments with parents via parent meetings in their child's Google Classroom. The dedicated teachers and staff have continued to collaborate as a family to educate all of our students. Teachers and staff received weekly newsletters to stay informed about what was going on in the school. Parents received monthly newsletters as well as automated calls to stay informed of school events and activities.

Our teachers engaged in ongoing professional development in areas such as HMH curriculum, Language Essentials for Teachers of Reading and Spelling (LETRS), DreamBox Learning, Defined Learning, Second Step, and iLead.
