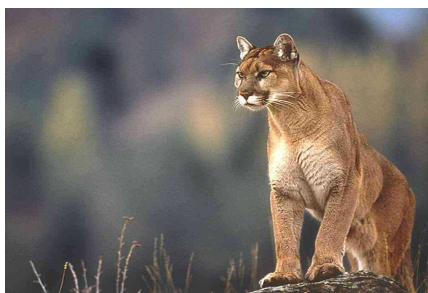

Goal 1: Increase Student Achievement

Data Driven Decision Making:
