About Middle School Points of Pride

SC READY is the end-of-year assessment given to all South Carolina students in grades 3-8 for ELA and Math. YMS has been working diligently to close gaps in learning that were exacerbated by COVID.

YMS has seen year over year growth in ELA for the last 3 years due in part to a focus on small group instruction, conferencing, and the implementation of an intervention reading program called Read 180.
