School Renewal Plans are created every five years. Faculty and staff reflect upon data and survey information to establish goals for the next five-year period. Hunter Street's plan for 2017-2021 includes the following goals:

Performance Goal Area: School Climate

By 2021, 100% of school level respondents completing the “YSD1 School and Safety Climate” survey will report positive feelings regarding safety as evidenced by responses of “4” or “5”.

Performance Goal Area: Student Achievement

By 2035, 70% of Hunter Street students will score level 3 (Meets Expectations) or higher on the ELA and Math portions of SC READY.

By 2035, 70% of Hunter Street fourth grade students will score level 3 (Meets Expectations) or higher on the Science portion of SC PASS.

Performance Goal Area: Teacher and Administrator Quality

By 2021, increase the number of GT (Gifted and Talented) endorsed teachers from 2 to 4 in grades 3 and 4.
