4. By 2021, increase the number of Gifted and Talented endorsed teachers from 2 to 4 in grades 3 and 4.

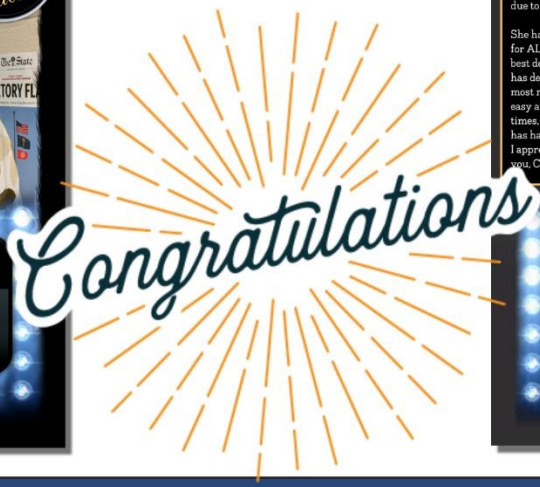
Report to Parents

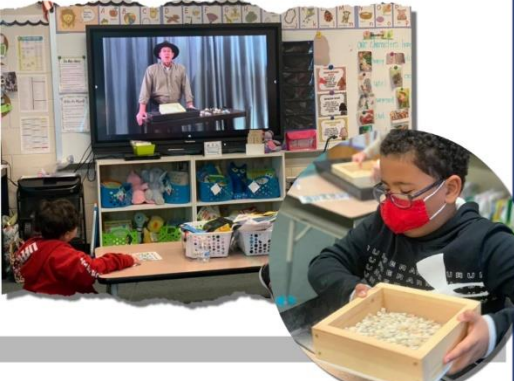
