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Mission Statement

The mission of Bethany Elementary School, in partnership with the parents and community is to prepare students to become productive, confident and responsible citizens by creating a safe, friendly, child-centered environment which effectively addresses the social, emotional, and intellectual needs of each child.

Performance Goals 2010-2016

- The percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score “exemplary” in English Language Arts and Research, Math, Science and Social Studies as measured by state PASS assessments will increase to target benchmarks.
 - ELA from 46.9% in 2009-2010 to 47% in 2010-2011.
(Actual growth: 57.1%-goal met)
 - Math from 52.3% in 2009-2010 to 53% in 2010-2011.
(Actual growth: 62.4%-goal met)
 - Science from 27% in 2009-2010 to 28% in 2010-2011.
(Actual growth: 31%-goal met)
 - S. Studies from 33% in 2009-2010 to 34% in 2010-2011.
(Actual growth: 40.7%-goal met)
- The percentage of parents satisfied with the social and physical environment of our schools as measured by the school report card survey will increase from 91% in 2009-2010 to 97% in 2015-2016.
 - Parents satisfied with social and physical environment from 91% in 2009-2010 to 100% in 2010-2011.
(Actual growth: 100%-goal met)
- The percentage of all core academic subject area teachers who are highly qualified as defined by NCLB in the appropriate content and level will remain at 100% through 2015-2016; and the percent of paraprofessionals who are highly qualified will remain at 100% through 2015-2016.
 - Highly qualified staff remains at 100%.
(Actual growth: 100%-goal met)
- The percentage of parents who participate in school-based activities will increase from 87.5% in 2010-2011 to 91% in 2014-2015 and maintain that level until 2015-2016.
 - Parents who participate in school-based activities from 87.5% in 2009-2010 to 95.1% in 2010-2011. (Actual growth: 95.1%-goal met)

- The percentage of students in grades 2-5 who meet the expected one year’s growth in math and ELA as measured by fall to spring MAP assessments will increase by 5% each year.
