

SCHOOL RENEWAL GOALS FOR 2010-2016

Goal: Based on data Bethel will focus on maintaining 100% of the teachers highly qualified as well as strive to obtain 100% of paraprofessional to be highly qualified.

100% of all Teachers and 92% of fall Paraprofessionals are Highly Qualified.

Goal: The percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score "met" or "exemplary" in ELA, Math, Science, and Social Studies as measured by the state PASS assessment will increase to targeted benchmarks on each assessment by 2016.

ELA Baseline – 93% to 94% in 2012

Math Baseline – 91% to 92% in 2012

Science Baseline – 85% to 85% in 2012

Social Studies Baseline – 86% to 87% in 2012

Goal: Bethel will focus on increasing the percentage of parents who attend and or participate in school based activities and also focus on addressing and reducing the number of incidences of bullying so parents feel safe sending their children to school.

Based on the K12 Insight Survey 95% of parents feel their child is safe at school and the percentage of parents who participated in school activities increase from 60% to 85%.

Goal: Bethel will focus on decreasing the percentage of students of Special Education and Free and Reduced Lunch subgroups from the previous PASS assessment.
