## Mission Statement

The mission of Crowders Creek Elementary School in partnership with the parents and community is to prepare students to become productive, confident, and responsible citizens by creating a safe, friendly, child-centered environment which effectively addresses the social, emotional, and intellectual needs of each child.

## Performance Goals 2010-2016

- The percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score exemplary in English Language Arts and Research, Math, Science and Social Studies as measured by state PASS assessments will increase to targeted benchmarks.

ELA from $62.5 \%$ to $65 \%$
Math from $64.5 \%$ to $65 \%$ Science from $39.8 \%$ to $40 \%$ Social Studies from $50.3 \%$ to $52 \%$

- The percentage of students in grades 2-5 who meet the expected one year's growth in math and ELA as measured by fall to spring MAP assessments will increase by $5 \%$ each year.
- The percentage of parents satisfied with the social and physical environment of our schools as measured by the school report card survey will increase from $91.1 \%$ in 2010-2011 to 97\% in 2015-2016.
- The percentage of parents who participate in school-based activities will increase from 93.3\% in 2010-2011 to $98 \%$ in 2014-2015 and maintain that level until 2015-2016.
- The percentage of all core academic subject area teachers who are highly qualified as defined by NCLB in the appropriate content and level will remain at 100\% through 2015-2016; and the percent of paraprofessionals who are highly qualified will increase from $86.9 \%$ in 2010-2011 to $100 \%$ in 2012-2013 and remain at 100\% through 2015-16.


In reviewing student performance on the PASS, over $90 \%$ of our $3^{\text {rd }}, 4^{\text {th }}$, and $5^{\text {th }}$ grade students met standard or were exemplary in ELA and math. Our school still needs to continue working on decreasing the number of students who were not met on PASS. At the end of the 2011-12 school year, we will review student performance on the MAP to determine if our students met the goal for one year's growth. We have implemented our district literacy plan, and our teachers meet regularly with district curriculum specialists to plan strategies to increase student achievement in all subject areas.

As a school, we aim to please our customers-our parents and students. We have implemented focus groups and random telephone calls to gain feedback to help us improve. We have instituted increased opportunities for parent participation through parent workshops and events such as TechWeek, media center events, family math night, and "What to Expect in Middle School."

Currently, Crowders Creek has met our goal for teacher quality with $\mathbf{1 0 0 \%}$ of teachers and paraprofessionals designated as highly qualified.
