Programs

Crowders Creek is a child centered school which focuses on excellence. We encourage students to seek opportunities to learn. Instructional support programs at the elementary level include Reading Recovery, gifted and talented instruction, Response to Intervention services, and special education services. Students also receive weekly instruction in art, music, physical education, and technology.

Curriculum

South Carolina adopted the Common Core State Standards for Mathematics and English Language Arts in the summer of 2010. The South Carolina Department of Education has begun the work of implementing the Common Core State Standards across the state. The Common Core State Standards will be fully implemented in South Carolina by the 2014-15 school year.

Commitment to Service

Crowders Creek faculty, staff, students, and parents have a commitment to public service. Our student council sponsors various service projects including canned food drives and recognition of those in need. The PTA assists with a holiday mitten tree and a pack the back food program for those in need. Teachers support various charities including Relay for Life through blue jean Friday donations. Our students also participate in various fund raising efforts for local charities. In the past three years, the school has donated over \$20,000 to Relay for Life.

Performance Goals 2010-2016

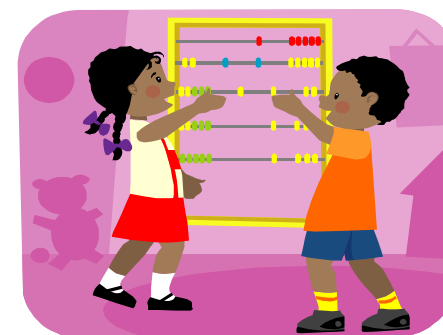
- The percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score exemplary in English Language Arts and Research, Math, Science and Social Studies as measured by state PASS assessments will increase to target benchmarks.
 - ELA from 62.5% to 65%
 - Math from 64.5% to 65%
 - Science from 39.8% to 40%
 - Social Studies from 50.3% to 52%
- The percentage of students in grades 2-5 who meet the expected one year's growth in math and ELA as measured by fall to spring MAP assessments will increase by 5% each year.
- The percentage of parents satisfied with the social and physical environment of our schools as measured by the school report card survey will increase from 91.1% in 2010-2011 to 97% in 2015-2016.
- The percentage of parents who participate in school-based activities will increase from 93.3% in 2010-2011 to 98% in 2014-2015 and maintain that level until 2015-2016.
- The percentage of all core academic subject area teachers who are highly qualified as defined by NCLB in the appropriate content and level will remain at 100% through 2015-2016; and the percent of paraprofessionals who are highly qualified will increase from 86.9% in 2010-2011 to 100% in 2012-2013 and remain at 100% through 2015-2016.
