Performance Goals 2010-2016

- The percentage of students in grades 3-5 who score exemplary in English Language Arts, Math, Science and Social Studies as measured by state assessments will increase to target benchmarks.

ELA: 62.5% to 65%

Math: 64.5% to 65%

Science: 39.8% to 40%

Social Studies: 50.3% to 52%

- The percentage of parents satisfied with the social and physical environment of our schools as measured by the school report card survey will increase from 91.1% in 2010-2011 to 97% in 2015-2016.
- The percentage of parents who participate in school-based activities will increase from 93.3% in 2010-2011 to 98% in 2014-2015 and maintain that level until 2015-2016.

- The percentage of all core academic subject area teachers who are highly qualified as defined by NCLB in the appropriate content and level will remain at 100% through 2015-2016. The percent of paraprofessionals who are highly qualified will increase from 86.9% in 2010-2011 to 100% in 2012-2013 and will remain at 100% through 2015-2016.
- Crowders Creek Elementary School will design curriculum and integrate technology using the Common Core Standards and State Standards.
