PERFORMANCE GOALS 2021-2026

Improve overall academic performance of all students in ELA by increasing the percentage of students who “meet or exceed” grade level expectations from 66.2% to 74% by 2026 as measured by SC Ready state assessments.



Improve overall academic performance in Math by increasing the percentage of students who “meet or exceed” grade level expectations from 81% to 85% by 2026 as measured by SC Ready state assessments.



Increase consistency and continuity in teacher quality and improve educator retention by increasing the percentage of teachers who return from the previous school year (excluding retirement and relocation) from 89.7% to 95% by 2026 as measured by School Report Card Survey.



Provide a physically, socially, and academically nurturing environment by increasing the percentage of students who indicate they are satisfied with the learning environment from 88.6% to 91% by 2026 as measured by the Student Opinion Survey.



Increase the academic progress of students with disabilities by increasing the academic progress points from 46.3% to 47.8% by 2026 as measured by SC READY.
