Northwestern's School Improvement Council had a primary focus on returning to in person meetings and establishing the criteria for Trojan Excellence. We took time each meeting to reflect on needs specific to Northwestern while acknowledging and celebrating achievements.

Our SIC supported an increased social media presence through the emphasis of our big four to support a safe and engaging learning environment. With social media, we want to promote a positive school image and celebrate the many achievements of our students and faculty and staff.

We were able to conduct our Summer Bridge Program which focused on preparing incoming freshmen for high school culture and procedures. Our school has been able to offer daily after school tutoring through ESSER funds to help with pandemic learning loss. In regards to our performance on the school report card, we've tracked and encouraged students to become completers through programs at our Applied Technology Center. We hosted ACT and SAT Blitzes to prepare our juniors for these standardized assessments. Our End-of-Course Examination teachers (Biology 1, Algebra 1, English 2, and U.S. History and the Constitution) use Mastery Connect to analyze data, provide differentiated groups, and assess students' mastery of their course standards. We have refined our MTSS program and work to provide targeted support to increase student outcomes.
