### SIC Outcomes for 2024-25:

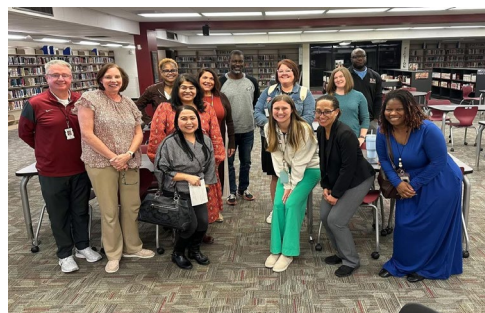
- Student focused rewards system for reducing undocumented absences
