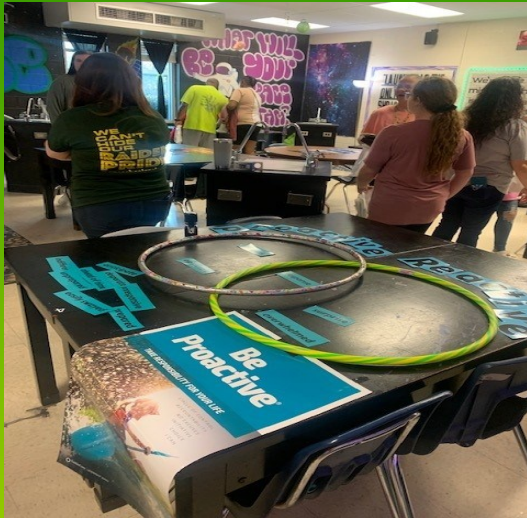


SIC ANNUAL GOALS

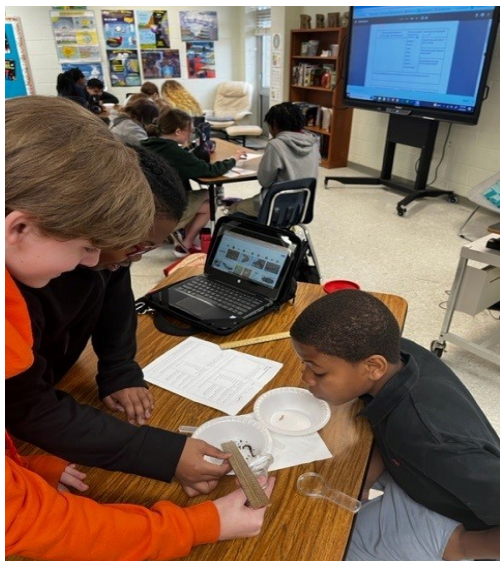

PBIS Program "P.R.I.D.E."

Rawlinson Road has implemented a school-wide Positive Behavior Support Program for it's 5th year. This program is a multi-tiered approach to social, emotional, and behavior support. The PBIS program includes proactive strategies for teaching and supporting appropriate student behaviors. Our goal is to establish a positive school climate in which appropriate behavior is the norm. Additionally, we have begun the journey to becoming a Leader in Me Lighthouse School.

PBIS at a Glance

P.R.I.D.E— Our students demonstrate Rawlinson Road "PRIDE" which stands for *Perseverance, Responsibility, Integrity, Dependability, and Excellence.*
