Student Achievement

Our students take Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) assessments three times a year, once in the fall, winter and spring. Kindergarten through 5th grade students take MAP assessments in Reading and Math. Third through 5th grade students also take MAP assessments in Language Usage. We look for growth from spring to spring.

Bellevue Elementary continued to have very good Math results on the SC READY assessment. Along with outstanding instruction from our teachers, the addition of academic interventionists have played a role in the academic growth at Bellevue.
