School History

The oldest school in Rock Hill School District Three, Ebenezer Avenue School was originally built in 1921. Located near downtown Rock Hill, the school served as a neighborhood school for grades



one through eight and now for the 2013-2014 school year pre-kindergarten through sixth grade. In 1986, the old school was demolished to make

way for a new facility. Students and teachers spent a year at the old Lesslie School during construction.

The new two story brick building opened in September 1987. The latest addition to the school's media center was completed in the fall of 1997.
