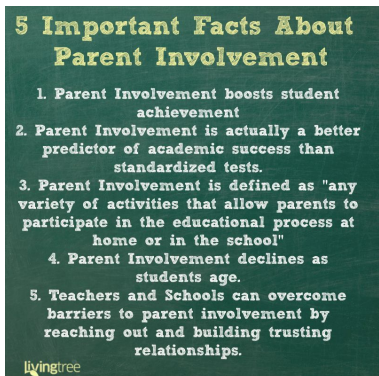


School Achievements
