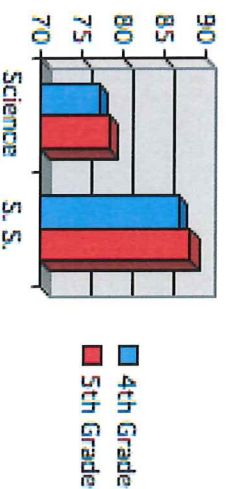
## SIC Annual Goals

## Student Achievement

Ebinport Elementary is very proud if its academic accomplishments.

### Percent Passing 2015 PASS



In Fall 2015, 68.29% of all students scored average to high on the MAP reading test. 70.48% of all students scored average to high on the MAP math test.

At the end of the 2015 school year, 75% of all students were at or above grade level according to F and P. 80% of all students had made a years growth in reading according to F and P.

- 1 of 3 language immersion schools (Core courses 50% English/50%Spanish) in the district
- We have enrollment of 630 students with approximately 65% free and reduced lunch and 105 ESOL students served
- All students receive weekly exposure to Mandarin Chinese and Spanish
