Spring MAP Results (Grades 3-5):

- Reading: 50.5% met projected proficiency, 42.0% at/above 60th percentile growth
- Math: 51.2% met projected proficiency, 50.5% at/above 60th percentile growth

On Spring MAP test 2025, Ebinport ranked:

- 5th in Reading and Math Achievement
- 3rd in Reading Growth
- 5th in Math Growth (out of 14 Rock Hill elementary schools)
